Timing of Modules

Study Components in a SIMTICS Module

Each SIMTICS module includes ~2–3 hours of focused study time, depending on the learner's pace and prior knowledge. The study experience typically includes:

- **Video Demonstration**
 - Initial viewing and later review
- **Text-Based Learning**
 - Procedure explanations, key terms, images, pop-ups, and links
- **Anatomy Section**
 - Interactive layers, labeled structures, and 3D models
- **Simulation Scenarios**
 - Learn Mode (3 scenarios, repeated twice)
 - Practice Mode (mock test style)
 - Test Mode (random selection)
- **Quiz**
 - 25 randomized questions from a larger question bank
 - Can be taken multiple times for reinforcement

Estimated Time Per Component

Component	Time Estimate
Text	45–60 minutes
Video	15–20 minutes
Anatomy	10–15 minutes
Learn + Practice Mode Sims	30–45 minutes
Test Mode Simulation	15–20 minutes
Quiz	15–20 minutes

Note: These times may vary depending on prior knowledge and module complexity. Learners are encouraged to revisit simulations and quizzes for ongoing reinforcement.
